


# ADMIN USER MANUAL

Here is a helpful guide for the administrator to use the admin side of the website.

## STEP ONE:


### CREATE A NEW PAGE

To create a new page for the website, you must select the CREATE button.



Once you select the CREATE button you will be sent to this page.


### CREATE PAGE



## STEP Two:

### EDIT A PAGE

To edit a page on the website, you must insert the page number that you want to edit and then press the Edit Existing Page button.


## STEP FOUR:

### EDIT THE MENU


To the menu on the website, you press the Menu button.
